I am calling on this District Council to install traffic calming measures or speed ramps in Grange Village

Reply to NOM:

An Garda Síochána, as the Road Traffic Authority has the ultimate responsibility for speed control enforcement.

Before implementing any traffic calming measures, it is essential to confirm the existence of a speeding issue. This involves a structured approach, beginning with a speed survey and consultation with An Garda Síochána where necessary. This will be followed by the installation of a temporary speed indicator signage and ongoing monitoring to access whether the issue persists.

Further interventions will be guided by the Infrastructure SPC document '*Traffic Management Guidance on Vertical Deflections*', and any physical infrastructure will be subject to planning and funding approvals.
