7.1 Councillor Richie Molloy (Ref ID 3039)

That Clonmel Borough District trim back the tree's in Heywood Drive in line with the tree's that were recently trimmed back on the N24 to ensure uniformity.

7.2 Councillor John Fitzgerald (Ref ID 3040)

That the Council would address urgent safety concerns at Marlfield Clonmel between Eircode E91 HY52 and Saint Patrick's Well Crossroads. The road has become very fast, still has an 80km speed limit, no road markings, no speed bumps, and is extremely narrow.

I would ask that measures be put in place to address this situation in the interest of public safety.

7.3 Councillor John Fitzgerald (Ref ID 3047)

Would the council consider installing road ramps/strips on the Cashel road across from Clonmel town football pitch, R688? Residents very concerned about the speed of traffic on this road (sometimes over 100kph) and with new entrance to Melview Nursery Home, entrance to housing estates and sports complex, residents are afraid that a serious accident will occur.

7.4 Councillor John Fitzgerald (Ref ID 3048)

That the traffic lights at the crescent shop be adjusted to allow pedestrians the time to cross the road. Some elderly people find that the lights change too quickly.

7.5 Councillor Pat English (Ref ID 3049)

That Clonmel Borough District upgrade the road surface on the Fethard Road adjacent to the entrance of Willow Park, Clonmel.

7.6 Councillor Pat English (Ref ID 3050)

That Clonmel Borough District clean around the three stone monuments on the Frank Drohan Inner Relief Road. The monuments were erected to commemorate Frank Drohan, former Mayor of Clonmel Corporation, the leader of the local Clonmel Irish Volunteers during Easter week 1916.

7.7 Councillor Pat English (Ref ID 3051)

That Clonmel Borough District look at improving the sight lines at the Glenconnor/Western Road Junction. The existing junction is very dangerous given the increase in traffic coming from the Glenconnor Road due to additional housing schemes constructed over the last number of years.
