That Clonmel Borough District would install a pedestrian crossing just before the mini roundabout at the Poppyfields due to speed of traffic in that area and difficulty for pedestrians crossing from housing estates to Poppyfields shopping centre.

8.2 Councillor Siobhán Ambrose (Ref ID 3057)

Whilst acknowledging the significant ongoing investment by Úisce Eireann in upgrading the drinking water supplies around Clonmel there has however been ongoing and serious disruption to drinking water supplies which is having a serious adverse impact on both the commercial /retail and residential communities in recent times which is not acceptable. Any planned works must contain contingency plans to ensure a continuous water supply for the Clonmel area and unfortunately this has not been demonstrated in recent times. Furthermore, if these contingency plans require additional resources during this time then they must be put in place 7 days a week to ensure continuity in supply as the current situation is just not acceptable. I am asking that the council to write to Úisce Eireann seeking a response to this urgent request.
