6.1 Notice of Motion in the name of Councillor Jim Ryan- ld 3055

I am calling on this District Council to install appropriate traffic calming measures within Two Mile Borris Village as a matter of urgency.

Reply to NOM

An Garda Síochána, as the Road Traffic Authority has the ultimate responsibility for speed control enforcement on all public roads.

Before implementing any traffic calming measures, it is essential to confirm the existence of a speeding issue. This involves a structured approach, beginning with a speed survey and consultation with An Garda Siochána where necessary. This will be followed by the installation of a temporary speed indicator signage and ongoing monitoring to access whether the issue persists.

Further interventions will be guided by the Infrastructure SPC document 'Traffic Management Guidance on Vertical Deflections', and any physical infrastructure will be subject to planning and funding approvals.

However, it should also be noted that as per the direction of Minster for Transport Darragh O'Brien, 30kph speed limits will be implemented where appropriate in specified locations in urban areas by Q1 2027. Therefore there will be no substantive physical works until such measures are implemented and allowed to bed in.

The above principle will apply to all villages in the MD unless a road improvement opportunity arises.

Presently the MD seeks to address speeding in the vicinity of schools within the parameters of the SPC document, as these locations are identified as being high risk areas.
